We recently received some COVID-related tax information from AFA National highlighting a new tax benefit for 2020.

Important 2020 Tax Update:

Due to recent tax law changes resulting from the Coronavirus stimulus bill, taxpayers will be able to claim up to \$300 in cash contributions made to a nonprofit charity this year as a deduction from their gross income if they take the standard deduction on their 2020 tax return. This deduction will ultimately reduce the amount of your income that's taxable. Follow this link to AFA to support our Air Force and Space Force today!

This year only - 2020 you can take a \$300 "Off the Top" deduction from your income taxes even if you don't itemize when you donate cash to AFA!
